Update: Academy Closure – Friday 26th June 2026

Dear Students, Parents and Carers,

Further to our previous communication regarding the closure of BOA Stage and Screen Production Academy on Wednesday 24 June and Thursday 25 June, we are writing to inform you that the Academy will also be closed on Friday 26 June.

This decision has been made due to the ongoing disruption to travel networks across the region. Continued transport difficulties are expected to impact the ability of learners and staff to travel safely to and from the Academy. As a result, all learners will be required to continue their studies remotely and complete all work assigned to them. As always, the health, safety and wellbeing of our Academy community remain our priority.

To ensure continuity of learning, details of all tasks and resources will be available via Microsoft Teams, and learners should check Teams regularly for instructions and updates from their tutors.

Please note that all assigned work must be completed and submitted via Microsoft Teams by **2:00pm on Friday 26 June**. As mentioned in the previous letter, failure to submit work by the deadline will be recorded in line with Academy expectations.

Learners involved in the production at The Old Rep Theatre are also required to remain at home on Friday and should not attend the venue. Tutors will be in contact with all students involved in the production today to outline the arrangements and provide further details. We would like to reassure students and families that the production is still planned to go ahead, and staff are working to ensure that preparations can continue effectively and safely.

We appreciate that this extended closure may cause inconvenience and thank you for your continued understanding, patience and support. We will continue to monitor the situation and provide further updates should they be required.
